Any increase in jail population will increase costs to the state. The Commonwealth pays the localities \$8.00 a day for each misdemeanant or otherwise local responsible prisoner held in a jail. It also funds most of the jails' operating toosts, e.g. correctional officers. The state's share of these costs on a per prisoner, per day passis varies from locality to locality. However, according to the Compensation Board's most ecent Jail Cost Report (FY 2005), the estimated total state support for local jails averaged \$28.35 per inmate, per day in FY 2005.
