5. Summary/Purpose: The bill authorizes nonprofit organizations, whose primary mission is to protect Virginia's natural resources, to receive the proceeds from a civil action they brought for the improper disposal of solid waste.

8. Fiscal implications: The bill will divert civil penalty revenue that currently is deposited in either the Virginia Environmental Emergency Response Fund or the treasury of localities. The amount of revenue that will be affected by the bill cannot be determined.
