# 4. Title: Prohibit VDOT from impeding ingress and egress from Cedar Green Road and Route 28 North in Loudoun County

#### 5. Summary/Purpose:

Prohibits the Virginia Department of Transportation from closing or otherwise impeding ingress to or egress from Cedar Green Road and Virginia Route 28 North in Loudoun County until all planned improvements on the Virginia Route 625 and Virginia Route 846 interchanges have been completed and Shaw Road between its intersection with Cedar Green Road and Virginia Route 846 (Sterling Boulevard) is widened from two travel lanes to four travel lanes exclusive of any turn lanes and in no case sooner than November 1, 2007.

#### 7. Budget amendment necessary: NO

8. Fiscal implications: Widening Shaw Road (Route 636) has been estimated to cost \$8 million in 2007 dollars. This \$8 million estimate covers preliminary engineering (PE), right-of-way (RW) and construction (CN) phases at a proportion of 15% for PE, 25% for RW and 60% for CN. This yields an estimated PE cost of \$1.2 million, a RW cost of \$2.0 million and a CN cost of \$4.8 million in 2007 dollars. Shaw Road widening is not listed in Loudoun County's Secondary Road Program. For this project to proceed, the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors would need to determine that this project is a priority in the Secondary Six Year Plan (SSYP) and allocate sufficient funds. This would require new allocations as opposed to diverting funds from current projects in the SSYP. This also assumes that state funds would be used since this segment of Route 636 is classified as Urban Local.

Assuming the above, a potential schedule would be: Begin PE - FY 08 (spring 2007) Begin RW - FY 10 (fall 2009) Advertise for CN - FY 13 (fall 2012) CN Complete - end of 2013

Estimate adjusted for inflation using VDOT's most recent Project Cost Estimation System (PCES): PE- \$1,842,000 RW- \$2,327,000 CN - \$6,367,000 Total - \$10,536,000
