Summary/Purpose:** Provides that any active duty members, activated guard or reservist members, or guard or reservist members mobilized or on temporary active orders for six months or more, that are either stationed or assigned by their military service to a work location in Virginia, and residing in Virginia, shall pay tuition to the public institution of higher education in which they are enrolled an amount no more than the amount covered by their military service Tuition Assistance program or the institution's in-state tuition rate, whichever is greater.

- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal implications:** This amendment seeks to permit all personnel whose duty station may not have a special arrangement contract as listed in the *Code of Virginia*, **\$** 23-7.4:2.F, to attend Virginia's higher education institutions at the institution's in-state tuition rate. According to the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia, the number of students affected by this legislation will have a minimal revenue impact on the Commonwealth.
