- **4. Title:** Agri-tourism Incentives Act; penalty
- **5. Summary/Purpose:** The bill creates the Agri-tourism Incentives Act to provide incentives for qualified farm businesses to increase investment in their farms and generate ancillary revenue from agri-tourism, such as allowing qualified farm businesses to have restaurants and provide overnight accommodations on agriculturally zoned land under certain conditions. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is tasked with administering this new program.

- 8. Fiscal implications: It is estimated that the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services will require one additional full-time employee to meet the responsibilities set forth in the bill, including establishing eligibility requirements, monitoring implementation, conducting evaluations of the program, and assisting localities. The estimated salary for the position is \$60,000, and fringe benefit costs are estimated at \$22,440 for a total personal services budget of \$82,440. In addition, nonpersonal services cost of \$17,560 are needed for expenditures such as state vehicles, lodging, per diem, office space, and general administrative costs. In the first year, recruitment cost of \$500 are also required.
