Summary/Purpose:** Authorizes a title insurance company, title insurance agency, or agent to pay to a settlement agent a portion of the premium that is payable on a title insurance policy purchased by the purchaser or borrower in the real estate transaction, where the payment is used to subsidize the costs of the escrow, closing or settlement services.
