4. Title Penalty for public dissemination of social security numbers

5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill proscribes under the Personal Information Privacy Act and the Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act the intentional communication to the general public of another's social security number regardless of whether the social security number was obtained from a public record or from a private source. The bill also adds a punishment for violation of the Personal Information Privacy Act subjecting a violator to civil penalties of \$1,000 per day, with each day being a separate violation.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Indeterminate

7. Budget amendment necessary: N/A

8. Fiscal implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how many individuals could be subject to a civil penalty for violating this proposal. However, any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited to the Literary Fund.
