4. Title Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, etc., exemption from licensure

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill provides an exemption from licensure as an architect or professional engineer for the design of on-site treatment works consisting solely of an anaerobic septic tank treatment system with gravity conveyance to a gravity-distributed subsurface drain field.

6. No Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) anticipates that this bill will have no significant impact on their agency.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.

11. Other comments: The bill still mandates that any “plans specifications, documents, or designs bear the name and address of the author and his occupation,” thereby still allowing some level of regulation and protection for these projects.
