4. Title Delivery of Criminal Warrants

5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires magistrates to deliver a copy of any criminal warrant issued at the request of a citizen to the attorney for the Commonwealth.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Indeterminant (see item 8)

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: According to the Supreme Court of Virginia, data is not available to determine the fiscal impact of this bill. Although the passage of this bill would increase certain costs (copying, postage or messenger service), it is not anticipated that the additional costs would be significant.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Magistrates, Courts.

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: There is an indication that the process of providing copies of warrants as outlined in this bill (not just at the request of a citizen) is already a standard practice in at least some magistrate offices. This bill is similar to SB997.
