Summary/Purpose:** This legislation proposes to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 32.1-174.4, requiring the Board (VDH Board of Health) develop regulations to implement a program to identify chronically noncompliant water systems and create additional mechanisms or enforcement options to eliminate underperforming systems. This legislation (and subsequent fiscal impact) does not include the implementation of the program.
