Dis wo by Fre Co	Summary/Purpose: Requires agencies covered by the Government Data Collection and ssemination Practices Act to respond to a data subject for inspection of his record in five orking days after receiving the request or within a time period as may be mutually agreed upon the agency and the data subject. The bill references the pertinent section of the Virginia redom of Information Act (FOIA) so as to treat requests made under the Government Data ellection and Dissemination Practices Act in the same manner as requests under FOIA, in terms response time and invoking applicable exemptions, etc. The bill also clarifies that charges for cument production shall be in accordance with FOIA provisions.
