5. Summary/Purpose: The bill authorizes the Marine Resources Commission to convey three parcels of state-owned land consisting of 1,200 square feet, 10,900 square feet, and 22,400 square feet to private parties, S.S. Marine Supply and Iola L. Lawson.

8. Fiscal implications: The revenue to the Commonwealth as a result of the property conveyance is unknown, because the fair market value of the property has yet to be determined. Proceeds from the sale are to be deposited to the Marine Habitat and Waterways Improvement Fund.
