- **4. Title** Child unattended in a car; penalty.

5. Summary/Purpose: Provides that it is unlawful for any person who is responsible for a child younger than six years of age to leave such child unattended in a motor vehicle if the conditions within the vehicle or in the immediate vicinity of the vehicle, including outside temperature, present a risk to the health or safety of the child. The penalty for a first offense is a \$100 civil penalty, for a second offense a Class 4 misdemeanor (fine up to \$250), and for a third or subsequent offense a Class 3 misdemeanor (fine up to \$500).
