4. Title Minimum wage; definition of employee.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill repeals the existing exclusion for persons who have reached age 65 from the definition of an employee under the Virginia Minimum Wage Act.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Indeterminate.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill may have a fiscal impact on state agencies because it increases the potential number of employees that are eligible for the minimum wage. However, the number of such employees in the employ of various state agencies at any given time is not known. Wage employment in particular is variable from one year to the next and from one state agency to the next. Because of this, the fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: All state agencies and political subdivisions.

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: SB758 is a companion to this bill.
