<b>Summary/Purpose:</b> The bill authorizes the Marine Resources Commission to convey two adjoining parcels of subaqueous land in the Elizabeth River in Norfolk to a private corporation, December Partners, L.L.C. The Commission is authorized to charge a reasonable fee for the administrative cost of conveying the property.

<b>Fiscal implications:</b> The bill states that prior payment of real property taxes will satisfy the fair market value of the parcels, and it permits the Marine Resources Commission to charge a reasonable fee for the cost of preparing any instrument to accomplish the conveyance.
