4. Title Approval of transmission lines

5. Summary/Purpose: Provides for coordination between electric utilities and localities regarding the designation of, or modification to, transmission line (150 kilovolts) corridors within local comprehensive plans. If a utility proposes a transmission line outside of a local comprehensive plan's designated transmission corridor or route, the locality may submit evidence at any hearing to the State Corporation Commission relative to the adequacy of designated corridors or routes in the plan. Additionally, requires the State Corporation Commission, at the request of the locality, to consider the costs and likely economic benefits of requiring the underground placement of the line and any potential impediments to timely construction of the line.
