8.	<b>Fiscal implications:</b> This bill requires that power generation facilities who increase their power generation in response to an order by the U.S. Department of Energy notify those persons who have requested such notification if the increase may potentially exceed air quality standards. For each day notification is not provided, the owner of the facility can be assessed a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 by the State Advisory Board on Air Pollution through the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). While the number of violations is indeterminate at this time, this bill may result in a positive revenue impact on the state. Any monies collected from penalties are to be deposited into the Virginia Environmental Emergency Response Fund.  While the fiscal impact is indeterminate and would be based on the number of violations, DEQ anticipates that this bill will not have a significant impact on their agency.
