4. Title Alcoholic beverage control; issuance of mixed beverage license.

5. Summary/Purpose: Authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to grant a mixed beverage license to an establishment in any county with a population of between 33,000 and 33,200 (Smyth County), which property is part of a commercial development project encompassing approximately 78.5 acres located approximately 1,200 feet from Exit 47 on Interstate 81.

8. Fiscal implications: According to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), the fiscal impact of the proposed legislation cannot be determined. The number of licenses that would be obtained is not known and the impact due to this legislation will not be known.
