4. Title Uniform Statewide Building Code; regulations; authority of localities; historic districts.

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill requires the Board of Housing and Community Development to promulgate regulations as part of the Building Code that authorize a locality to require building permits for the installation of replacement siding, roofing, and windows in buildings within designated historic zoning districts within the locality.

8. Fiscal implications: There would be some costs to the Department of Housing and Community Development associated with the promulgation of the new regulations.
