4. Title Pilot programs for drug and alcohol treatment in local and regional jails

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill allows for drug and alcohol treatment programs for inmates housed within local and regional jails. The amended bill strikes the provision that would require the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to develop a tracking mechanism and a plan for expanding use of these programs statewide, and to give technical assistance to local and regional jails.

6. Fiscal Impact: The amended bill has no fiscal impact

8. Fiscal implications: The amended bill strikes all provisions that would have a fiscal impact on the Department.
