4. Title Auditor of Public Accounts; review security; governmental databases containing personal information.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill provides that the Auditor of Public Accounts shall periodically review the security of any database or information system maintained or operated by any agency or other governmental entity of the Commonwealth that contains personal information regarding any individual to ensure that appropriate measures are in place to prevent unauthorized or unlawful access to this information. On an annual basis, the Auditor shall report the results of its review to the General Assembly and make recommendations for new or revised security measures, if needed.

8. Fiscal implications:

The Office of the Auditor of Public Accounts reports they already conduct a review of the security of databases during the course of their regular audits. Since the bill does not require it be done annually for every agency, the office believes they can prepare a report of the results from their existing audit work that will meet the requirements of the bill. The time to prepare a report would be minimal so there really is not fiscal impact.
