ele pro dis reg rate cor trai pro	Summary/Purpose: Electric utility restructuring. Extends the period during which rates for extric service are capped from December 31, 2010, until July 1, 2013. The measure also evides that, upon the end of the capped rate period, rates for default service provided by stributors will be based on prudently incurred costs, rather than on prices in competitive gional electricity markets. Other provisions clarify that the capped rates and default service es for utilities that have divested their generation assets will be determined in a manner insistent with the terms of the orders of the State Corporation Commission approving the insfer of such assets. The measure also revises the criteria for adjustments to capped rates to evide that, rather than being allowed to recover increases in transmission and distribution inability and environmental costs through single-issue proceedings, after July 1, 2007, certain lities may seek to recover increased costs through annual full rate cases.
