4. Title Health insurance credits; teachers and other local school board employees.

5. Summary/Purpose: Health insurance credits; teachers and other local school board employees. Increases the monthly health insurance credit for retired teachers from \$2.50 to \$4.00 for each full year of the retired member's creditable service. The bill also eliminates an overall cap to the credit, and adds retired full-time, salaried employees of local school boards as recipients of the credit. The bill is applicable for current and future retirees from positions as teachers or full-time, salaried employees of local school boards.
