5. Summary/Purpose: This bill provides that the searchable database of state agency expenditures and revenues shall not include activity of private gifts, including endowment funds and unrestricted gifts received by state-supported institutions of higher education. The bill clarifies that all appropriated funds and other sources under the control of a state-supported institution of higher education shall be included in the database and that the exclusion of the private gifts activity shall not affect the public access to such records unless otherwise specifically exempted by law.
