**4. Title: Department to install signs requiring vehicles to display lighted headlights; penalty.**

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

VDOT is required to install signs requiring lighted headlights at each approach to every bridge, tunnel, culvert, causeway, and other area where traffic safety may be diminished by limited visibility or sight distance regardless of time of day or weather conditions.  
Secondary traffic offense as provided in § 46.2-113.
