4. Title Virginia War Memorial.
5. Summary/Purpose: This bill requires the State Treasurer to advance a loan of $\$ 3.5$ million to the Department of General Services for the state share of the construction of an educational wing for the Virginia War Memorial in the form of a short-term treasury loan, with no interest, upon certification by the Secretary of Administration that $\$ 2$ million in private funds have been raised, are available, and will be used to support construction.
6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: See item 8, below.
7. Budget amendment necessary: Yes. Item $C-4$, to authorize the treasury loan
8. Fiscal implications: Chapter 3, 2006 Acts of Assembly, Special Session I, provides $\$ 2.5$ million ( $\$ 500,000$ from the general fund and $\$ 2.0$ million in special fund appropriation) for the project. The introduced budget bill (SB 750) also adds $\$ 1.5$ million from the general fund to support the construction of this project (Item C-4). The remaining appropriation needed to complete this project is $\$ 2.0$ million.

The Department of Treasury and the Department of Planning and Budget are authorized to provide anticipation loans for capital projects. However, according to Section 4-3.02 of Chapter 3, a treasury loan for a capital project is only authorized when the agency has developed a plan for financing the capital project and it has an identified source of anticipated revenue (i.e. federal funds) to repay the treasury loan. This bill authorizes a loan against the general fund.
