as	<b>Summary/Purpose:</b> Provides that the proceeds from any bingo game commonly referred to "winner-take-all" or "Lucky Seven" games shall not be included in determining the gross reipts for a qualified organization.

8.	<b>Fiscal implications:</b> In customary "winner-take-all" games, the winner receives the entire "pot" of money and the organization receives nothing.
	In customary "lucky seven" games, both the winner and the organization receive money and therefore revenue could be generated, but the amount is indeterminate. The intent of the legislation would prohibit this revenue generation and could reduce the amount of general fund revenue collected.
	This assumes that organizations opt to host "winner-take-all" and/or "luck seven" games.
