4. Title Faculty representative to the State Council of Higher Education.

5. Summary/Purpose: Requires the Governor to appoint a nonvoting faculty representative to the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) who will act in an advisory capacity. The faculty representative must be employed in a full-time teaching position at a public institution of higher education in Virginia. The faculty representative may not be considered a member of the State Council for any purpose, including establishing a quorum and making official decisions, and may be excluded from executive sessions or closed meetings.
