15 16	ordered to outpatient treatment; penalty. A. It shall be unlawful for any person involuntarily committed admitted to a facility or ordered to
17	<i>involuntary outpatient treatment</i> pursuant to Article 5 (§ 37.2-814 et seq.) of Chapter 8 of Title 37.2 to
18	purchase, possess or transport a firearm during the period of such person's commitment. A violation of
19	this subsection shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.
20	B. Any person prohibited from purchasing, possessing or transporting firearms under this section
21	may, at any time following his release from commitment an involuntary admission to a facility or
