2 An Act to standardize public participation guidelines for executive branch agencies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. § 1. That on or before July 1, 2008, the Department of Planning and Budget, in consultation with the 8 Office of the Attorney General, shall (i) develop model public participation guidelines meeting the 9 requirements of § 2.2-4007.02 of the Code of Virginia and (ii) provide these model public participation 10 guidelines to each agency that has the authority to promulgate regulations. By December 1, 2008, each agency shall either (a) adopt the model public participation guidelines or (b) if significant additions or 11 changes are proposed, promulgate the model public participation guidelines with the proposed changes as fast-track regulations pursuant to § 2.2-4012.1 of the Code of Virginia. Agency action in adopting the 12 13 14 model public participation guidelines in accordance with clause (a) shall be exempt from the operation 15 of Article 2 (§ 2.2-4006 et seq.) of Chapter 40 of Title 2.2 of the Code of Virginia. The repeal of any 16 existing public participation guidelines shall occur in the same regulatory action as the promulgation of 17 the model public participation guidelines required by this section.

\$ 2. The model public participation guidelines adopted pursuant to this act shall apply to the
promulgation and adoption of regulations for which a notice of intended regulatory action is filed in
accordance with \$ 2.2-4007.01 of the Code of Virginia on or after January 1, 2009.

§ 3. However, any amendments made after January 1, 2009, to an agency's public participation
guidelines adopted as required by this act shall be subject to the requirements of the Administrative
Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq. of the Code of Virginia).

§ 4. For the purposes of this act, the terms "agency" and "regulations" mean the same as those
 terms are defined in § 2.2-4001 of the Code of Virginia.
