5 6 WHEREAS, Thomas W. Farrell, a respected citizen and outstanding attorney, died tragically after 7 being struck by a car during a morning run on the streets near his home in Roanoke County on January 8 28, 2008; and

9 WHEREAS, Thomas "Tom" W. Farrell was born in Rochester, New York, on February 1, 1958, the 10 son of Bill and Mary Farrell, graduated from Saint John Fisher College in Rochester, and moved to Northern Virginia in 1980; and 11

WHEREAS, Tom Farrell worked as a legislative associate for a congressman and for several 12 13 associations in the Washington, D.C., area during law school and graduated from George Mason 14 University School of Law in 1987; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated and gifted lawyer, Tom Farrell began his distinguished law career as an 15 16 assistant commonwealth's attorney in Danville from 1987 to 1990 and moved with his family to Roanoke in 1990 to join the law firm of WootenHart PLC as a partner; and 17

WHEREAS, Thomas Farrell graduated from Leadership Roanoke Valley in 2005 and was a member 18 19 of many professional organizations, including the Roanoke, Danville, Virginia, and American Bar 20 Associations and the Virginia Association of Defense Attorneys; and

21 WHEREAS, a strong believer in civic duty, Tom Farrell was a member of the Roanoke Valley Breakfast Lions Club for 15 years, serving as president in 1996 - 1997, and he was honored with the 22 Club's Lion of the Year award in 1993 and 1995 for his many achievements and contributions to the 23 24 community; and

25 WHEREAS, a wonderful father and a fine role model and mentor to all young people, Tom Farrell 26 was a coach for the SW County Youth Softball and Soccer League for many years during his daughters' 27 participation in youth sports and an enthusiastic supporter of the Hidden Valley High School Athletic 28 Boosters Club: and

29 WHEREAS, always willing to help his fellow citizens, Tom Farrell was a faithful member of the 30 Our Lady of Nazareth Catholic Church and was active in the church's many missions in the community; and

32 WHEREAS, a member of the Roanoke Athletic Club for 18 years, Tom Farrell enjoyed keeping 33 physically fit, was a swimmer and an avid runner, and he ran and finished the Richmond Marathon in 34 2006 and 2007; and

35 WHEREAS, Thomas Farrell will be fondly remembered for his great devotion to family, his playful 36 sense of humor, and his compassion, perseverance, and dedication to running; and

37 WHEREAS, Tom Farrell will be greatly missed by his loving wife Connie and his beautiful daughters Elizabeth and Katie; his parents, Bill and Mary; his sisters, Mary, Teresa, and Sharon and his 38 39 brother, Bill, and their wonderful families; his colleagues in the legal community; and numerous friends 40 and admirers in Roanoke County; now, therefore, be it
