Cavalry Division based at Fort Hood, Texas, Staff Sergeant Kiernan served in Iraq in 2004 and was
awarded a Bronze Star during his first tour of duty; he was deployed to Iraq again in October 2006; and
WHEREAS, known for his generosity and his great concern for his fellow soldiers, Staff Sergeant
