WHEREAS, Sarasi Jayaratne, a resident of Sterling and a student at Potomac Falls High School, has achieved national recognition for exemplary volunteer service by receiving a 2008 Prudential Spirit of Community Award; and

WHEREAS, Sarasi Jayaratne is a great example of how a young person can take an idea and make a huge impact on the lives of others; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the strength of our communities, and the overall vitality of American society depend, in great measure, upon the dedication of young people like Sarasi Jayaratne who use their considerable talents and resources to serve others; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend and congratulate Sarasi Jayaratne as a recipient of a Prudential Spirit of Community Award; and, be it
