2 3 Celebrating the life of Petty Officer First Class Luis Ariel Souffront. 4

5 6 WHEREAS, United States Navy Petty Officer First Class Luis Ariel Souffront died on February 7, 7 2008, as a result of enemy action while conducting combat operations in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Petty Officer First Class Souffront, an Explosive Ordnance Disposalman, was assigned 8 9 to a SEAL team with a Naval Special Warfare Group in Virginia Beach at the time of his deployment 10 in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, a native of Miami, Florida, Petty Officer First Class Souffront enlisted in the Navy in 11 July 2000; after graduating from Naval Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois, he attended 12 several specialized training schools and completed Navy Explosive Ordnance Disposal School at Eglin 13 14 Air Force Base in Florida in July 2002; and

WHEREAS, Petty Officer First Class Souffront was assigned for two months in 2002 to Explosive 15 16 Ordnance Disposal Training Unit One in San Diego, was next sent to Guam, where he served with Explosive Ordnance Disposal Mobile Unit Five for three years, and then in November 2005 was 17 transferred to the Virginia Beach-based SEAL team; and 18

19 WHEREAS, as a combat-support specialist, Petty Officer First Class Souffront trained and fought 20 shoulder-to-shoulder with SEAL team members and played a critical role in Special Warfare missions; 21 and

22 WHEREAS, during his service, Petty Officer First Class Souffront earned numerous awards and 23 decorations, including the Purple Heart, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, two Navy Achievement 24 Medals, a Combat Action Ribbon, two Good Conduct Medals, the National Defense Service Medal, the 25 Iraq Campaign Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, the Global War on Terrorism 26 Service Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, two Sea Service Deployment Ribbons, two 27 Navy/Marine Corps Overseas Service Ribbons, and the Rifle and Pistol Marksmanship Medals; and

28 WHEREAS, Petty Officer First Class Souffront will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his 29 beloved parents and numerous other family members, friends, and teammates; and

30 WHEREAS, Petty Officer First Class Souffront's death is a reminder of the perils faced daily by the 31 thousands of Americans who serve in our armed forces overseas and whose devotion to duty places 32 them in harm's way; now, therefore, be it

33 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring. That the General Assembly hereby 34 note with great sadness the loss of a courageous and patriotic American, Petty Officer First Class Luis 35 Ariel Souffront; and, be it

36 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 37 for presentation to the family of Petty Officer First Class Luis Ariel Souffront, United States Navy, as 38 an expression of the high regard in which his memory is held by the members of the General Assembly 39 and the citizens of the Commonwealth.
