WHEREAS, committed to quality education in the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), Dr.
 Glass has been a leader and an active member of numerous professional organizations, interacting and exchanging ideas with other administrators; and

WHEREAS, an avid community supporter, Dr. Glass has given his time and talents to many civic
organizations over the years, serving as president of the Danville Lions Club and the Danville Area
Council of Community Services, troop committee chair of the Boy Scouts of America Troop 300, and
executive board member of the Boy Scouts of America's Blue Ridge Mountains Council; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Glass was honored as Workforce Development Professional of the Year for the
 VCCS in 2003 and named an Honorary Firefighter of the City of Danville Fire Department; now,
