11 12	1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12 13	§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for certain veterans; fees.A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
13 14	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
15	applicant special license plates.
16	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
17	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
18	United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
19	design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of
20	persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
21	plates under this subsection.
22	C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
23	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
24	United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
25 26	incorporates an emblem of the United States Army. D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
20 27	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
28	United States Air Force, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
29	design incorporates an emblem of the United States Air Force.
30	<i>E</i> . On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
31	the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license
32	plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of
33	state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.
34	E.F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
35	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.
36 37	F.G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam War
37 38	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War. G-H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the
39	Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that
40	campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in
41	addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are
42	issued.
43	H.I. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates
44	issued under subsection A, D , E, ΘF or G of this section.
