That § 22.1-98.2. Certain agreements; adjustment of state share for basic aid.  Any school board of a school division in which fewer than 359 /200 students were included in average daily membership for the preceding school year, upon entering into certain cost-savings agreements with a contiguous school division for the consolidation or sharing of educational, doministrative, or support services, shall receive the state share for basic aid computed on the basis of period of 15 years.  The Board of Education shall develop eligibility criteria for such cost-savings and service-sharing agreements and for the adjustment to the state share for basic aid computed on the basis of period of 15 years.  The Board of Education shall annually report to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate for operatione school board receiving the adjusted state share shall not use the addivitional funds. The perform of the local school board receiving the adjusted state share shall not use the addivitional funds for education all purposes and shall not be used to reduce local operating expenditures for public education from the prior fiscal year.
