WHEREAS, devoted to their hobby, enthusiastic RVARC members generously give their time and considerable expertise to assist anyone interested in learning more about amateur radio and electronic communication; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2008, RVARC and its members and guests held a gala celebration to commemorate 75 years of outstanding service to the greater Roanoke Valley metropolitan area; now, therefore, be it
