WHEREAS, Bubba Waymack was a Honeywell employee for 33 years, and he served as a justice of the peace and was a magistrate for the Sixth Judicial District for 33 years; and

WHEREAS, a Master Mason for 51 years, Bubba Waymack was a member of the Royal Arch Chapter No. 7 in Petersburg and served as Worshipful Master of Prince George Lodge No. 115 from 1961 to 1963 and as the most senior District Deputy Grand Master for the 29th Masonic District in 1964; and

WHEREAS, devoted to his community, Bubba Waymack was a member of the American Legion, a founding member of the local volunteer fire department, a former deacon at Gregory Memorial Presbyterian Church, and a member of the board of trustees at Prince George Christian Church; and

WHEREAS, Bubba Waymack will be fondly remembered and sorely missed by his wife of 56 years, Marlene; his children, Jacqueline, George, and Bruce, and their spouses; his grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and many other family members and dear friends; now, therefore, be it
