Designates the entire length of Newman Road in Fairfax County a Virginia byway

6. Fiscal Impacts are unavailable

Fiscal implications: VDOT's cost to fabricate and install Virginia Byway designation signage would be dependent on factors such as the number of locations required and the type of installation required. Typically, costs would be approximately \$100 or less per sign, including fabrication and installation. Based on the length of the road, VDOT estimates two signs would be posted. Since the lifespan of a sign is 10-12 years, maintenance would not be a significant cost contributor.
