**4. Title:** **Reckless driving; drivers of certain heavy trucks exceeding posted speed limit guilty thereof.**

**5. Summary:** Reduces from 20 mph to 10 mph the amount by which drivers of heavy trucks must exceed the posted speed limit to be guilty of reckless driving.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Passage of this legislation will result in an increase of the number of reckless driving tickets issued to drivers of heavy vehicles. Although this will increase the revenue collected from these violations, it is impossible to determine the extent of the increase. Reckless driving violations result, at minimum, in a class 1 misdemeanor. Any additional fines collected would be deposited in the Literary Fund.
