3. Committee: Transportation.

4. Title: Violation of weight limits; disposition of penalties.

5. Summary: Violation of weight limits; disposition of penalties. Allows Stafford County to collect half of penalties for citations issued by county deputies.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Though the total impact is unknown, see "Fiscal Implications" below.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would allow Stafford County to assess liquidated damages on overweight vehicles and divert this revenue for other purposes that would otherwise be deposited to the Highway Maintenance and Operating Fund. Liquidated damages are currently a dedicated source of revenue for the Highway Maintenance and Operating Fund, and revenue generated from these assessments should be directed to maintaining the roads and repairing such damage.

DMV estimates that this bill would require programming changes to its systems and operations that would utilize 267 work-hours and cost approximately \$12,015.00.
