5. Summary: Requires the Department of Criminal Justice Services to establish compulsory training standards and publish a model policy for law-enforcement personnel regarding death notifications.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), compulsory training standards already exist to train law enforcement officers to handle death notifications.
