3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Institutions of higher education; notification of mental health treatment.

5. Summary: Requires the board of visitors or other governing board of any public institution of higher education to establish policies and procedures requiring the notification of a parent of a dependent student when such student receives mental health treatment at the institution's student health or counseling center and the student is found to be a danger to himself or others.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill requires that the boards of visitors at each public college or university establish policies and procedures for parental notification of a dependent student when the school determines a student may have suicidal tendencies or may be an imminent danger to others. The cost to the schools to prepare written policies should be minimal.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All public colleges and universities
