The bill changes the criteria for appointment from the current requirement that there be a member chosen from each congressional district to at least one member, but no more than three, from each Department of Game and Inland Fisheries District. As a qualification for appointment, each Board member must have held a resident hunting or fishing license for three consecutive years. Currently, each member of the Board is appointed by the Governor; under the provisions of the bill, six members would be appointed by the Legislature and five would be appointed by the Governor.
