4. Title: Abolishing the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority.

- **5. Summary:** The proposed legislation abolishes the enabling legislation creating the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority (the Authority). The bill repeals the sections of the Code of Virginia setting the establishment and membership of the Authority and the taxes, fees and charges that support the Authority's operations and programs.
- 6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.
- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation does not impact state revenues, as the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority is a separate entity. Some state agencies are involved in the collection of certain revenue streams of the Authority. The cost of collection is recovered from collected revenues; therefore there is no expenditure impact to the Commonwealth.

House Bill 3202 identified several transportation projects in the Hampton Roads area the Authority was to construct with their revenue stream. With the repeal of the Authority, less or no funding for the transportation projects will be available. The proposed legislation does not offset the loss in regional revenue with additional state funding. The table below illustrates the estimated revenues of the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority.
