5. Summary: The bill allows any person creating and operating stream restoration banks in more than one jurisdiction to file general erosion and sediment control specifications for stream restoration banks annually with the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill will expand the Department of Conservation and Recreation's general erosion and sediment control specifications oversight to include those associated with stream restoration banks where applicable. The associated workload increase should be manageable with existing budget and staff resources.
