- **8. Fiscal Implications:** Revenue impact is unknown as DMV cannot forecast the number of additional DV license plates that would be issued if the definition of "disabled" is amended to 50%. However, for each additional plate issued, the Department would see a loss of \$49.50 \$39.50 for the registration fee and \$10.00 for the special plate fee. Also, the Northern

Virginia and Hampton Roads Transportation Authorities would lose revenues (\$10 per vehicle) on vehicles with a garage jurisdiction embraced by these Authorities.
