3. Committee: Education

4. Title: **Children's teaching hospital; Board of Education to supervise programs for school-age children.**

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to supervise provision of education and training to school-aged children who are patients at the children's hospital associated with the Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) Health System Authority.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation clarifies the Board of Education's authority to make provider payments for Special Education - State Operated Programs - to the Children's Hospital in Richmond, Virginia. Such payments are based on an established relationship that the hospital has with the VCU Health System Authority. This authorization requires no additional funding beyond what is currently budgeted.
