- **8. Fiscal Implications**: Fines resulting from repeated violations of HOV lane regulations will be punishable as follows in the Hampton Roads Planning District:

For a second offense within a period of five years from the first	By a fine of \$250;

For a third offense within a period of five years from the first	by a fine of \$500;
offense,	and
For a fourth and subsequent offense within a period of five years	By a fine of \$1,000.

There is not enough information available to reliably estimate how much additional revenue may be collected from increasing the fines, or if the fine increase would be a deterrent to misuse of the HOV lanes. Any additional fines collected under this provision would be deposited to the Literary Fund.
